- Created a weekly feedback system which led to a 75% improvement in quality defects over an 8-month period. The system also included daily reporting, ensuring associates knew their standing and managers could provide coaching.
- Coordinated creation and release of 100,000 new bins. Maintained high quality standards through a strict daily audit, walk-through schedule, and ensuring the construction team met contract expectations.
- Led twice-weekly Quality Review meetings, with production managers, to provide information on trends in defects, associate quality performance, and up-coming quality and capacity challenges.
